CONSIGNMENT POLICY

1. Articles will be accepted for consignment during regular store hours. Items must be clean, pressed, or dry-cleaned and on hangers or folded neatly. Items must be in season. Fall and winter items may be brought in July 1 thru November 30. Spring and Summer items may be brought in January 1 thru May 31. Items will be kept for the entire season.
2. Items must be ready for immediate display. Please make sure all items are in good condition and clean. No dust, tears, holes, ripped seams, broken zippers, bad wrinkles, stains, or clinging animal hair. Smoke or any other odors are unacceptable. Clothing must be in style with sizes marked. If items are not ready for immediate display, Mrs. Tiggy Winkle's will launder your items at a charge of 50 cents per item and \$1.00 per dress.
3. Mrs. Tiggy Winkle's will attempt to sell your items for the best price available. We will determine the selling price of each item and, **upon request**, provide you with a listing of items and prices. We reserve the right to reduce the price of any item for in-store sales promotions at any time during the contract. Items will go through a markdown process with a maximum markdown of 75%. We reserve the right to remove any item from the selling floor at any time.
4. You will be advised of any unacceptable items. It is your responsibility to collect these items within 7 days. After 7 days items automatically become the property of Mrs. Tiggy Winkle's and will be donated to needy causes.
5. You will receive 45% of the rack price of clothing. 50% of the rack price of nursery furniture and equipment. (Rack price excludes any buyer's fee that may be added).
6. We will pay consignor in person for sold items anytime during normal business hours upon request. If consignor chooses to spend the check in-store, they will receive a 10% discount.
7. All reasonable care will be taken of articles consigned to the store. However, Mrs. Tiggy Winkle's Children's Consignment Shoppe will not be responsible for any damage or loss of any item by any person or act of God (including fire, flood or theft). All items are left at the consignor's risk.
8. We thank you for consigning with us. We are most anxious to sell your merchandise and please help us to grow by telling your friends and relatives about our store.
